**Montgomery, IN:** The Glen Oaks Community College golf team finished tied for 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Vincennes University Invitational played Friday and Saturday at the Country Oaks Golf Club in Montgomery, Indiana.

Glen Oaks entered the second round tied with Danville Community College for second place, three shots behind leader Oakland State University who shot 308. Danville shot a final round 305 to win the team championship. The Vikings ended the event tied with the first round leader after firing a second round 309.

Glen Oaks also had a second place finish in the individual event as sophomore Brian Denny shot 74-76. Teammate Mike Prior finished fourth shooting 77-75. Harrison Charmichael of Danville finished with a two day total of 149 good for a one shot win.

Comments:

**Coach Heiple on Team's performance:** "I think that we are moving in the right direction. We are happy with a second place finish, but it is important for us to learn from the mistakes that cost us this championship. This team has tremendous potential and we are quickly learning what we need to work on to reach our goals that we have set for the spring."

**Coach Heiple on Brian Denny:** "Brian will be the first to tell you that he should have won this event. He was disappointed in his play early on Saturday. Brian is a tremendous competitor and has had himself in contention after the first day in both of our events. He needs to come out of the gate a little stronger at the beginning of the round. That is something we will work on with his routine and mental approach and I look for him to start winning events soon."

**Coach Heiple on Mike Prior:** "I am pleased to see Mike bounce back after struggling at St. Francis. This will be the first of many top five finishes in his collegiate career. Mike has a high ceiling and as we keep adding elements to his game he is only going to get better and better."

**Next Action:** Glen Oaks will host the New Balance Invitational at Klinger Lake C.C. September 14<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 A.M. (36 Holes).
