

PHLEBOTOMY TECHNICIAN ADMISSION PROCESS – FALL 2010

- 1. Register for admission to the college**
- 2. Declare Phlebotomy Technician program interest**
- 3. Meet Accuplacer (or other course placement determined by the college) basic math and English criteria:**
 - a) COM 063 Reading for College or placement in COM 111-Business/Technical Communications or higher on Accuplacer test.**
 - b) COM 073 Essentials for College Writing or placement in COM 111-Business/Technical Communications or higher on Accuplacer test.**
 - c) Placement in NSM 052 Per-Algebra or higher on Accuplacer test OR meet corresponding ACT/SAT scores.**
- 4. If course placement criteria not met, student may enroll in appropriate remedial course/s to bring skill level up to criteria.**
- 5. Complete course prerequisites: (minimum of a 2.5 GPA required – with no grade lower than 2.0)**
 - a) ALH 218 Medical Terminology**
 - b) NSA 101 Introduction to Anatomy and Physiology or NSA 105 Principles of Anatomy and Physiology**
- 6. SUGGESTED COURSE ROTATION: (minimum of a 2.5 GPA required at all times – with no grade lower than 2.0)**

SEMESTER ONE:

- a) ALH 250 Medical Law and Ethics**
- b) ALH 222 Disease Conditions**

SEMESTER TWO:

- a) ALH 230 Medical Office Laboratory**
- b) BAC 111 Business Communications (to be developed for fall)**

SEMESTER THREE: (AN OVERALL GPA OF 2.5 MUST BE MET TO ENTER EXTERNSHIP – NO GRADE CAN BE LOWER THAN 2.0 – ALL PROGRAM INSTRUCTORS MUST RECOMMEND THE STUDENT FOR EXTERNSHIP PLACEMENT)

- a) Complete externship preparations**
- b) Complete ALH 285-Phlebotomy Technician Externship**
- c) Complete suggested preparations and review for Phlebotomy Technician exam (online) through the ASCP (American Society of Clinical Pathology-Route #2)**
- d) Complete Phlebotomy Technician exam**
