1. Meeting was called to order at 12:03 p.m.

3. Old Business:

  - Open Arms – The Three Rivers faith based community is putting together a fund to help the homeless. A church will be opened to the homeless from September thru April to give them a warm meal, shower and a place to stay for the night. They are also hoping to be able to give those in need of groceries a gift card with strict rules as to what can be purchased. The officers discussed that we should use the money raised from the

Staff/Faculty Appreciation luncheon to go to this fund. Thelma Kassee made a motion to help support this event. Cindy Cummings seconded. Motion passed.
