The 2011-2012 Dean's Scholarship

Purpose: The Dean's Scholarship is an opportunity for successful high school graduates to begin their college career while saving substantially on tuition costs.

Terms of Scholarship: The Dean's Scholarship may be used for all education related expenses each year up to awarded amount. Student must enroll full-time (12+ credits) each semester. The scholarship may be renewed for a second award year if the student maintains a 3.0 GPA while at Glen Oaks. A typical Dean's award is \$2000 per year.

Minimum qualifications to apply:

- Graduating high school class of 2011
- Minimum 3.0 Cumulative GPA through the end of their 1st semester or 2nd trimester of 12th grade
- Take ACT or SAT or ACCUPLACER Assessment Evaluation

Application Deadline:

The Glen Oaks Financial Aid Office must receive **all** materials by **4 pm, Monday, March 14, 2011**. (No exceptions)

Application process:

1. Complete and submit the [Presidential & Dean's Scholarship Application](#).
2. Submit an official high school transcript.
3. Submit an application for admission to Glen Oaks Community College (available on line at www.glenoaks.edu).
4. Submit test results from ACT or SAT or ACCUPLACER Assessment Evaluation.
5. Submit a required short essay: **Describe your future goals and how attending Glen Oaks Community College would be a stepping stone for attaining those goals.** (No more than one page)

NOTE: To take the Glen Oaks Community College ACCUPLACER Assessment Evaluation. Testing is available hourly Mon. through Thurs. 8:30am - 5:30pm., hourly Fri. 8:30am & 1:30pm. Students will need to reserve a seat for one of these testing times by contacting the Tutoring and Testing Center at 294-4270.

Dean's scholarship recipients will be expected to serve as a goodwill ambassador. Time commitment may vary but expected 2-3 hours per semester.

All applicants will be notified of their status in April.
