How to Apply for a Glen Oaks Community College Scholarship

1. Complete the 2011-2012 Scholarship Application Form

- Deadline for scholarships is April 1, 2011.
- Check all scholarships for which you are applying.
- Only apply for scholarships for which you meet the criteria.
- You are encouraged to select a program of study category for which you are eligible; typically only one will be awarded.

2. Attach your essay to this application.

- Typing your essay is encouraged.
- Use double-spacing and a readable font style and size.
- Essays are evaluated on good attention to content, composition, style, organization, clarity, and mechanics.

3. Have an Application for Admission on file at Glen Oaks Community College.

Apply online by going to www.glenoaks.edu and clicking on Apply On Line.

4. Have your high school transcript on file at Glen Oaks Community College.

- You may obtain a copy from your guidance office and attach it to this application in a sealed, official high school envelope.
- You can request that your high school guidance office send us a copy directly.

5. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

- Complete this online at www.fafsa.gov
- The code for Glen Oaks Community College is 002263.
- FAFSA will then send your results directly to us.

Essay writing tips

1. Make sure you answer the question.
2. Be yourself and be original.
3. Don't "thesaurize" your composition. Big words don't necessarily mean big scholarships.
4. A good ending is important.
5. Leave it alone for a while. Go back later and take another look.
6. Give your draft to others to review.
7. Revise, revise, and revise!
