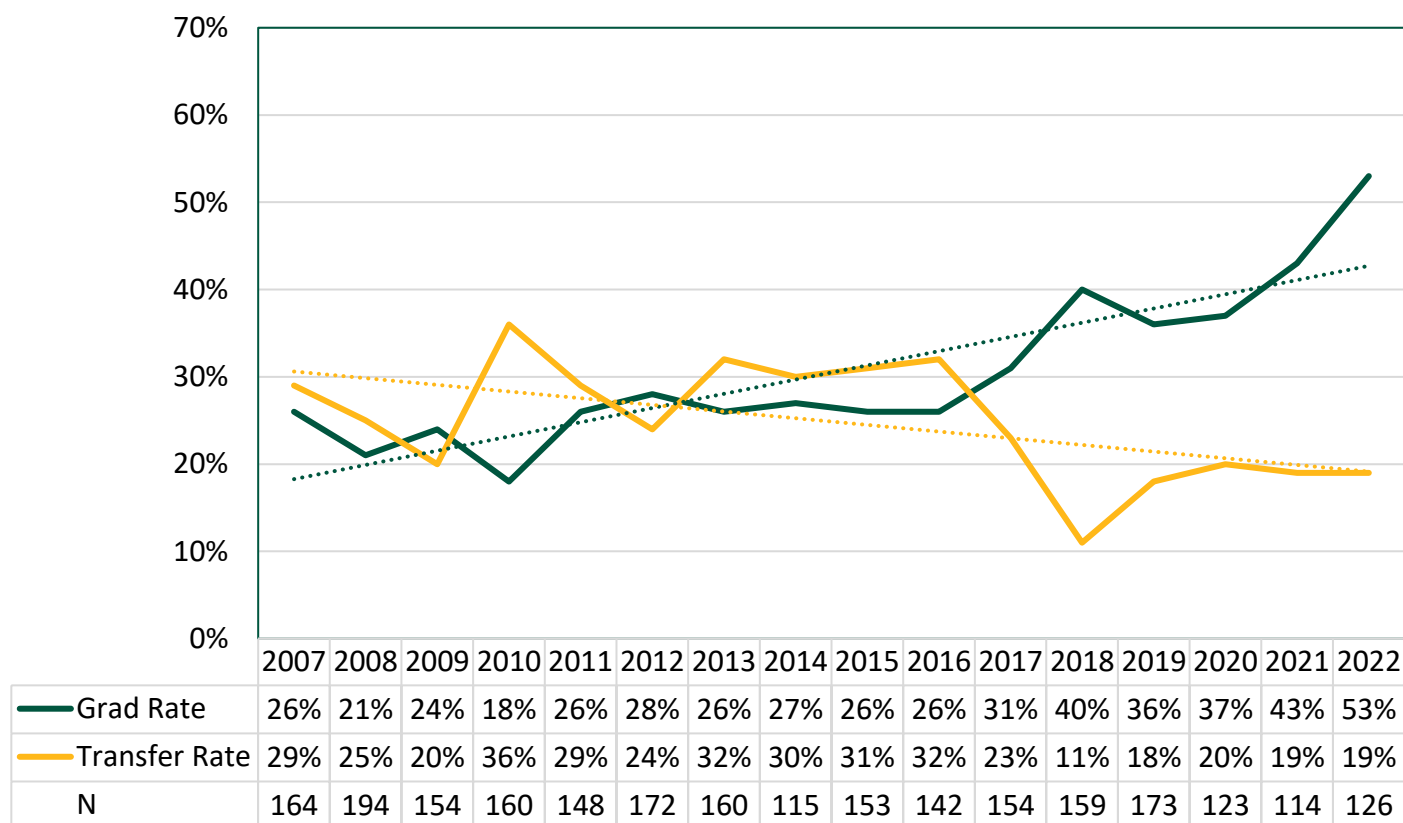


IPEDS Graduation & Transfer* Rates over Time
