<input type="checkbox"/> I am a non-citizen who entered the U.S. after turning 26, -OR- I entered the U.S. as a lawful non-immigrant on a valid visa and remained in the U.S. when I turned 26 or older.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. SUBMIT a copy of your birth date from a driver's license or state ID, or birth certificate or passport, - AND- 2. SUBMIT documentation of immigration entry date into the U.S.: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For entry after age 26 – A date stamp on the I-94 form; OR a dated passport immigration stamp For proof of status in U.S. until you turned age 26 – A letter from the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) indicating your entry date; OR a student visa form (I-20) or other valid U.S. passport visa stamp. A Resident Alien Card (Green Card) is not sufficient proof of date of entry.
<input type="checkbox"/> I am a male U.S. citizen, permanent resident alien, refugee or political asylee age 26 or older, who did not register for selective service as required by law. Eligibility for aid will be determined by the financial aid office based on documentation submitted. Ignorance of the law is not excusable.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. SUBMIT a Status Information Letter from Selective Service - request a letter at www.sss.gov -AND- 2. SUBMIT an explanation describing your failure to register for selective service, including any extenuating circumstances, if any, and state whether or not you knowingly or willfully did not register.
<input type="checkbox"/> I am/was in the armed forces on active duty. Note: This does not apply to members of the Reserve and National Guard who are/were not on active duty.	SUBMIT a copy of the applicable document that reflects active or prior duty. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A copy of your DD214 Form, "Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty," showing military service in the armed forces -OR- A letter from your unit commander documenting your active duty status.
<input type="checkbox"/> I am under age 18 and unable to register at this time.	
<input type="checkbox"/> I was born a female or am a transgender male assigned the sex of female at birth and am not required to register.	
<input type="checkbox"/> I was born before 1960 and was not required to register.
