


Unduplicated SJC HS Student Count, Disaggregated by Student Type




High school student enrollment over the past 11 academic years has shown an increase from 341 to 801.

Early middle college student enrollment increased from 47 in its first year, 2015-16, to 162 in 2023-24. DE/CTE students increased from 341 to 639 over the past 11 academic years.

2023-2024 Academic Year, by HS Student Type (N=801)



In the 2023-24 academic year, DE students account for almost half of the total high school enrollment. CTE students represent approximately one-third, while EMC is approximately 1/4 of the population.

In the 2023-24 academic year, White/Caucasian students comprise 65% of the high school enrollment. Hispanic and Black/African American students represent 17% and 1.5%, respectively. Overall, 57% of high school dual enrolled students are female.
