Methodology:

Cohort denominator includes all traditional students new-to-GOCC in the 20/FL term, by academic program. Persistence metric includes individuals who earn the given award within the 3-year time period. Enrollment is evaluated only in fall semesters; winter & summer terms are excluded. Only students in a declared program during the cohort fall semester are evaluated for persistence.

Example: Jane Doe has AAS in Business as an active program code in 20/FL. If she graduates at any time between 20/FL - 23/SM, she is included in the persistence rate. If she does not complete, but is enrolled in the AAS in Business program in 21/FL, she is included in the 1-year persistence rate. If she continues to be enrolled in the same program in 22/FL, she continues to persist. If she is no longer enrolled in the AAS in Business in 23/FL, she is removed from the numerator (no longer considered persisting). This is the case even if she has changed to a different active program.
